A graduate of Charlotte Country Day School and the University of Georgia, where he earned a B.A. in Political Science and a Certificate in Global Studies, Peacock went on to build a successful career in financial services. He currently serves as President of The Pomfret Financial Company, Inc., an independent insurance and business-planning firm, and is affiliated as a financial advisor with Northwestern Mutual.

Peacock's commitment to public service is reflected in his time on the Charlotte City Council, where he served as an At-Large member from 2007 to 2011.
